Scholarship Opportunities

Australian Government has invested over \$300 more in studentships for international students. Australia has offered over 3,000 Australia Awards scholarships and short courses to students from over 55 countries. You could be eligible for one in 2021. As an example, as of October 2020, there are about 522 scholarships available for those pursuing mechanical engineering in Australia, while there are about 524 for those pursuing civil engineering only.

Education System – AUSTRALIA EDUCATION SYSTEM

The Australian education system provides primary, secondary and tertiary education.

• School education (Primary and Secondary)

School education is compulsory for children between the ages of 6 and 16 years. It is compulsory primary school - Runs for seven or eight years, starting at

Kindergarten/Preparatory through to Year 6 or 7.

- 1. The secondary school is from 5 to 11 or 6 to 11
- 2. High school Runs for (2) years, years 11 and 12.





TERTIARY EDUCATION:

Tertiary education includes tertiary institutions, higher education and vocational education and training (VET)

English language courses

Higher education: bachelor's degree, master's programs, a doctorate degree.

Australia's education system is distinguished from many other countries by the Australian Qualifications Framework (AQF). Australia's government guarantees quality education while promoting study options.

COST OF EDUCATION IN AUSTRALIA

The tuition fee for a Master's program from an Australian University would cost an international student around AUD 35,000 for one year. The engineering course in Australia would cost around AUD 35,000 a year. More technical courses like an MBA from any of the top 5 universities in Australia will cost

COST OF LIVING IN AUSTRALIA

Australia remains a popular choice for students because of the high standard of living as well as the wide variety of options for them. Below are the approximate costs entailed for an Indian student on average.

Scholarships

- 1. Hostels and Guesthouses- AUD 80 to AUD 280 per week
- 2. Home-stays- AUD 235 to AUD 325 per week
- 3. Rentals AUD- 165 to AUD 400 per week
- 4. On-Campus- AUD 90 to AUD 280 per week
- 5. Shared rentals- AUD 85 TO AUD 200 per week

Other living expenses:

- 1.Food- AUD 80 to AUD 250 per week
- 2. Phone and internet- AUD 20 to AUD 55 per week
- 3. Gas and electricity- AUD 35 to AUD 150 per week
- 4. Public transport- AUD 15 to AUD 50 per week
- 5. Entertainment- AUD 25 to AUD 200 per week

Application Procedure

Here's a summary of what options you have for different programs in higher education

Intake Deadline

Semester 1 (February intake) October-November Semester 2 (July intake) April-May

Visa Process

- Application form (Student's details must be exactly same as in passport)
- 10th Mark sheet and certificate
- 12th Mark sheet and certificate
- English Proficiency Document
- Statement of Purpose
- Syllabus (if applying for credit exemption)
- Work Experience letter and salary statement (if applicable)
- Marriage Certificate (if applicable)
- Spouse academics (if applicable)
- Spouse current activity proof (if applicable)
- A medical checkup is also mandatory

- Diploma/Degree Mark Sheets (all semesters including backlogs) and degree course completion certificate
- Provisional/Degree Certificate (must mention the class, certificate should have been issued by the University)
- Letter of instructions (for some Universities only)
- Supporting documents for gap (if gap is longer than a year)
- Copy of Passport
- Application fees (if applicable)
- Resume
- Name Change Affidavit (if applicable)



TERTIARY EDUCATION:

Do you plan to work in Australia after your studies? Australian government offers Post Study Work Stream (PSW) for working in Australia to eligible graduates of higher education degree. As an international student, you'll need to apply for a Post-Study Work Visa (PSW) that allows you to stay and work in Australia for a visa period of two, three, or four years, depending on the highest educational qualification you

Eligibility for Post Study Work Visa

The requirements for an eligible post-study work visa are that Secondly, you should have at least two years of academic study in Australia from the Bachelors's level or above. To pass the course, you have to make sure the course is accredited, registered with the C.R.I.S.O., and that it has not been completed in less than 16 months.

Basic Entry Requirements:

Level of Studies Eligibility and English Language Requirements Undergraduate - A good academic record in High School Certificate or 12 years of schooling.

Some courses such as Computing and Engineering will require Mathematics and /or Science as pre-requisites.

EMPLOYMENT PROSPECTS

Student visas will allow you to work full time during vacation.

When you are a student, Australia can offer you to work in industries such as:

Once you have completed a Bachelor, Master, or PhD degree, you are eligible for a Post-Study Work permit under the temporary Graduate visa. This allows you to stay back in Australia temporarily after your studies in order to gain practical experience working in your field. You can also head off to any other country to seek employment based on your Australian degree's reputation.




